Spring Festival 2022 The Classic American Chicken Sandwich

- P3, P4 & P5: These groups will learn the basics of a chicken sandwich and a hamburger. For their activity, I have laminated parts of a burger (chicken breast, hamburger patty, lettuce, mayonnaise, tomato, cheese, etcetera) which are then glued to velcro strips. Also they will be making a chef's hat with decorative name tags pasted onto them. P3 will have their names into it but P4 and P5 can write it and glue it.
- Grades 1 and 2: These groups will play an interactive matching card game, where they
 learn about the different elements of a chicken sandwich (as explained in the video) and
 will try to match them with their pairs. You can prepare and google slides with a photo of
 the chicken sandwich and then with all the steps.
- Grades 3 and 4: These groups will create a decorative name badge like the professional chefs wear. Then they will do the same activity as the previous ones, but will also learn about the various tools and extra items involved in making the sandwich, such as an apron, tongs, oil, pan, etcetera. Later on they will watch the video and will make the sandwich sticking each laminated ingredient with velcro.
- Grades 5 and 6: These groups will watch my video, complete a vocabulary worksheet
 where I explain in detail the origins and the preparation of this trademark sandwich, and
 will later on assemble their own sandwiches (the ingredients will have been prepared,
 and they will be wearing gloves and aprons). Before assembling the sandwich, they will
 watch me do it in the video. The session before they can revise the vocabulary playing
 with the cards game.
