

How to make an African pot.



1. Take a piece of clay
2. Make a round ball
3. Pinch in the middle and make a hole
4. Move your three fingers inside the hole in a circle to make the hole bigger
5. Press above the middle to make a neck
6. Continue working on the base until you have a nice round base
7. Go back to the neck and continue working on it by passing your fingers around it until it is separated from the base.
8. Lastly work on the lips by passing your four fingers around it to smoothen the edges.
9. Smoothen any crooked edges. Your pot is now finished.

The lid

1. Start by making a ball
2. Flatten it to make a small plate or pinch it to make a lid for the pot.

The setting.

- African pots are supported by three stones. They MUST three, not more or less.
- Arrange the three stones in such a manner that they form a triangle
- Put the sticks across the triangle in every corner.
- Put the red paper that will act as fire.
- There you have your African pot on fire.
